Maximum Grant: \$700 each

As stated on our website (<u>www.MCPAW.org</u>):

- Grant awards will <u>NOT</u> be made for routine and preventive veterinary care, vaccinations, or spay/neuter procedures.
- Grant awards will be paid directly to the treating veterinarian.
- Documentation from the vet including the diagnosis <u>and</u> procedure cost estimate is required along with the application form.
- The maximum benefit per grant is \$700 per 12-month period. Any veterinarian fees above the grant amount are the responsibility of the pet owner/grant requestor.
- Grant awards will be based on availability of funds.
- Tax reporting obligations are the sole responsibility of the grant beneficiary and/or his/her/their tax professional.
